PAGANS/WICCANS in COUNTRY AREAS * – PARTICIPATE in CIRCLE WORKSHOPS FREE **

***I welcome enquiries from W.A. & N.T. but must advise that due to travel distance, different requirements are needed. If you are an Urban Pagan/Wiccan & are interested in participating in the Seed Temple Project, please let me know.**

In the Natural Magick & Divinity Training (Earthgate Tradition) there is a practice of training a Triskellion, a three-member core group who can work the Gate Rite (Circle ritual) by themselves if necessary and act as the driving force behind the formation of a Coven. This is not an “instant Coven” formula, and suits people who realize that this is an organic process that rarely happens overnight, at least not with any long-term success worth mentioning. By teaching the self-empowering practices of Magickal Religion, the Church of the Ancient Mysteries supports the formation of local groups, promoting the transformation of “congregation” into Priest/esshood. It is recommended that the process begin with a Seed House (Study Group) to accelerate research and learning; then progress to Sacred Arts Guilds for developing ritual observance of the Esbats & Sabbats. Out of this practice of the Sacred Arts (detailed in the next Newsletter) an ongoing Seed Temple (Ritual Working group) may form the nucleus for the birthing of a Coven.

If you are a magickal partnership or a three-person core group of sincere students/practitioners of natural magick/witchcraft and you want to start a Seed Temple – an ongoing Study Group & Ritual Working group, with the intent to form a Coven –

(1) I will travel to the nearest regional centre to you and conduct a **Circle Workshop Weekend**, which includes the option of attending an evening orientation lecture only. The workshop will be free for your partnership /core group. ****There may be accommodation and catering costs, depending on the venue. This is why it is wonderful to get a private venue of suitable size and ambience with indoor and outdoor working options; and have it self-catered (BYO) – that way we keep the costs down as much as possible.**

What's the catch? In order to be able to do this, I will need a **minimum of ten bookings for either the workshop/s or my services/consultations** (see **MY SERVICES** below, and for more details go to <http://www.ancientmysteriesnet.org/services.html> .

To make a Circle Workshop viable, we need at least four, preferably five people other than myself, and of course, the more the merrier in terms of genuinely interested participants!

(2) If you also want to receive **ongoing support** for your partnership/core group for a year via telephone & email, I will also make C.A.M. General Membership available (See <http://www.ancientmysteriesnet.org/membership.html>) for \$100 (usually \$150). This will suit those who are genuinely active in working with people, because “it is the squeaky wheel that gets the grease” – I don't chase after people to spoon-feed them, so you need to be actively asking me questions based on real experience in order to get the benefit of this deal!

“Faery Seduction and Otherworld Companions”

Faery/Non-Human Contacts & the Vampire Connection

One somewhat obscure strand of (post-Christian) folklore (mainly Southern European) holds that vampires originated with Judas Iscariot. Because Judas had betrayed Christ to the Romans, he and his family were cursed. The Bible relates that Judas committed suicide because of his guilt; suicides in vampire folklore were very likely to come back as vampires, so this may have helped contribute to the belief that vampires originated with Judas. According to this tradition, vampires descended from Judas were usually identifiable by their red hair.

In Celtic tradition at least, people with “red hair” are traditionally held to have more of the “power”, the free-floating kind of life force/etheric, auric or “psychic” energy than the average – I would describe this as being a particularly fine and porous energy body that is very difficult to manage. (“Red hair” used to be a code phrase meaning that the person was “fey” or a witch, someone with power, regardless of their physical hair colour!) Inanna Arthen’s observation that “vampires” exist in the physical world but are “not quite human” suggests a non-human component in their energy and consciousness, either as a result of an unconscious invasion/possession by Devic/Faery or other energies, or as a result of a past or other life imprint from the Devic or other non-human evolutions/”kingdoms”.

The ancient body of oral folk tradition concerning human interaction with Faery/non-human beings from a realm close to ours, is too extensive and universal to dismiss. In the “Psychic Self-Defence” chapter “The Pathology of Non-Human Contact”, Dion Fortune observes that there are some people who are intensely charismatic and lovable; yet do not seem to possess any notion of such human feelings as gratitude, loyalty, compassion, good faith, honesty, etc. They tend to create suffering and trouble for those who love them, while they themselves feel like they are aliens amongst us, unhappy and lonely. They are often small or very slender, have unusual strength and stamina, being prone to brain-storms, surges and exhaustions of nervous energy. Their ability to bring through the pure elemental forces of their native realm, either inspires hatred and fear, or attracts those who are already unbalanced and unstable. Although they cannot be considered “evil” per se, the state of “fascination” or astral rapport with people of non-human evolution is always a risky business, as their elemental energies can be too potent and unbalanced for ongoing human exposure. That is one variation of possibility, but as I pointed out in Raven Lodge #1, I don’t believe that any of us are necessarily one fixed and linear identity; and although there may be such a thing as the Immortal Individuality, the

so-called Higher Self, I think it is a much more amorphous and fluidic Spirit than is commonly perceived.

According to Inanna Arthen, in her very credible take on “vampirism” (full article at <http://www.earthspirit.org/fireheart/fhvampire.html>) “A vampire is a person born with an extraordinary capacity to absorb, channel, transform, and manipulate “pranic energy” or life force. She also has a critical energy imbalance which reels wildly from deficit to overload and back again. This capacity for handling energy is a gift, but the constant imbalance of her own system is the cause of the negative behaviour patterns and characteristics which may be notable about a vampiric person.”

“Fresh blood is the highest known source of pranic energy (life force). Human beings have practiced blood-drinking for many reasons throughout history, but... only real vampires can directly absorb the pranic energy in fresh blood, and for this reason some real vampires are attracted to blood and find different means of obtaining it.”

“(Absorbing) energy in much more subtle ways... is the mechanism that causes real vampires to inflict harm on others and themselves if they fail to recognize what is happening and do conscious work on transforming their inner natures. They will continue to incarnate in this pattern until they take action to change it.” Arthen goes on to describe in detail the physiological and psychological symptoms of vampirism, noting that “some of them are found in ordinary human behaviour. Real vampires are identifiable partly because they have a majority of the symptoms, not just one or two.” The aspects of vampire lore that relate to the spiritual/sexual energies of Kundalini, featuring with predictable crudity in the popular vampire fare of film and novel, are addressed in my **Winged Circle Journal** (see <http://www.ancientmysteriesnet.org/newsletters.html>)

Arthen opines: “Vampirism is the dark, or unfocused, side of a certain kind of psychic talent, one which has been developing for many lifetimes. It is destructive only when a vampire either refuses to face the truth about herself and work with her abilities... The most important step on her path is complete self-awareness: of her relationships, patterns, energy levels, and all other personal qualities... Knowledge, awareness, and control are the lessons real vampires must learn in order to harness their abilities.”

The following was extracted from a recent Pravda Online article (For clarity I have unfortunately had to correct some of the hilarious “Russian English”, bit of a shame really). It gives a good round-up of how common the “energy-parasitism” form of vampirism really is. Life feeds on life. There are conscious and benevolent ways to do this and there are unconsciously predatory ways:

Russian parapsychologist, Sergei Nikodimov, is certain that energy vampirism is a part of every-day reality. A lot of people will probably say that they sometimes experience weird unpleasant feelings and weariness after even a short conversation with others, whether it is a friend or a stranger. Paraphrasing the Professor: “Numerous research works by bioenergetics specialists all over the world showed that people can be conditionally divided into two major categories: vampires and donors. Each person radiates with live biological energy, which he or she can give to someone or take from someone. This quality of give and take forms with every human being during the moment of birth. If a baby is born as an energy vampire, this child is extremely capricious. When they grow, they try to follow parents everywhere on their heels and even try to sleep with them at night. As a rule, the energy exchange happens on a subconscious level. However, a human body senses this invisible communication too and reacts with fatigue, headache, etc.”

Sergei Nikodimov believes that energy vampires act instinctively and most probably do not realise their dangerous effect on other people.

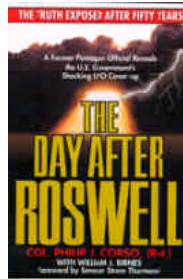
... "Energy vampires subconsciously provoke scandals to refresh themselves with the power of contradictions. Any person becomes defenceless in the state of anger: this is exactly the moment when vampires "feed themselves." They always try to visit the sites of tragic accidents. A lot of energy vampires can be passionate fans of sports games, such as football, for instance: huge stadiums accumulate a vast amount of psychic energy. Energy vampires hate being alone: they always need to have someone beside them, whom they can talk with at any moment. They usually say phrases like: "Stay with me a little, I am bored," or "Don't leave me alone, I'll die." In addition, they constantly want others to feel sorry for them, which irritates donors into giving their energy away to them.

In some Co-Dependent relationships, instead of the more benign symbiosis, there is a marked energy imbalance due to one individual being more dominant. The symptoms of the drained partner can be near-identical to vampirism in severe cases, but this is more a case of psychic parasitism, whereas vampirism proper is a deliberate attack. It seems that true vampirism involves astral projection on some level, and the forcible possession of one energy-vehicle by the will of a being or individual who is not the rightful owner of that energy-body. The aspects of this phenomenon are many and varied, as are the frequency-levels on which it can occur.

One example of vampirism can occur when an individual has a strong desire to remain connected to their body even after death. Under compulsion from the higher astral body, the phantom, or lower astral body, instead of breaking the cells down to return the body to the Elements, begins to hold the cells together. The result is that the corpse maintains a kind of vegetative life; does not decompose, being sustained by either the individual's higher astral body, often as not accompanied by, or under the control of, more sinister beings from the Innerplanes. To prevent all decomposition processes, more vital force from the physical plane is vampirised from living animals or humans, especially women, whose reproductive capacity makes them ideal "energy cows".

Dion Fortune (in "Psychic Self Defence") gives a ripping yarn about the dispatching of an unpleasant vampiric spirit which had made its way into London from the Western Front of WWII, the earth-bound soul of an Eastern European soldier. With traditional knowledge of how to avoid the Second Death (the disintegration of the higher astral body), this individual maintained himself in his lower astral body or etheric double by not only vampirising the wounded, but hunting with intent for a "protégée", a victim who would "take up the trade" as it were, thus providing an ongoing source of nourishment. After a fairly good run of migrating from one host to the next, this vampire-spook finally met its match in one of Dion's adept teachers, who apparently absorbed into himself (don't try this at home kids) the etheric substance of the earthbound soul, so that it was forced to "cross over". Stay tuned; in coming newsletters we'll wander further through this strange garden of otherworldly contacts, human and non-human...

WEIRD NEWS/BOOK REVIEWS



ROSWELL, NM - UFO CRASH - July 1947

Something crashed - or was shot down - in Roswell, New Mexico in July 1947. A few days later tight government security was set up around the farm on which the crash occurred. Something was taken away in trucks. Witnesses saw the crash. Many saw the wreckage and the bodies. Through the years they have come forward. Films and documentaries have been made about the crash. Various books based on eye-witness accounts have been written.

“The Day after Roswell” by Col. Philip J. Corso with William J. Birnes; © 1997
(Pocket Books 98) Rosewood Woods Productions Inc; ISBN 0-671-01756-X
(Paperback)

While the first version was published in hardcover in 1997, Corso provides new evidence for the presence of alien intruders in this pocket paperback edition. Whether or not you believe his contention, the governmental sources and documentation presented by the former Army intelligence officer is impressive. Once you understand the historical context (in the midst of the Cold War soon after World War II, with Orson Welles having recently inspired panic in citizens with his fictional War of the Worlds radio broadcast), the military deciding to cover up a real-life alien ship becomes more credible. Corso also gives an explanation of why reports were so multi-various and conflicting. The book is presented in a novel-like form, and has been criticised for not providing such basics as a table of contents, an index, source notes, and a list of references. According to one experienced researcher (Karl T. Pflock), when Corso makes claims that are objectively checkable he often gets it very wrong.

This book makes the sensational claim that debris from the 1947 UFO crash at Roswell spurred the development of high technology in the U.S., thanks to reverse engineering after the author's secret "leaks" to defence contractors. Col. Philip J. Corso was an army intelligence officer for 21 years, and served on Gen. MacArthur's staff in Korea, on Eisenhower's National Security Council, and in the Pentagon under Lt. Gen. Arthur G. Trudeau. It was for Trudeau that Corso did his UFO work, mostly in the areas of integrated circuits, lasers, and fibre optics. Corso also says that he saw one of the alien bodies from Roswell in 1947, and that the Star Wars program was developed as a deterrent to hostile UFO activity. Corso, who died in 1998 at the age of 83, was considered to be a rabid right-winger who was deeply suspicious of the comsymps at the CIA.

If this book is a concoction of lies, then the fact that a man of advanced years and with an apparently honourable record of service as a U.S. Army officer would tell such stories is very important in itself. Why would such apparently credible people make such incredible claims? If you read enough of books like these and watch enough episodes of "The X Files," you soon become politically neutralized under the disinformation onslaught. UFO researchers don't know what to make of this book, and that is probably the whole point of such material! If nothing else, then the book is

a great read and does come across very convincingly if you are not well-versed in the background of his claims.

It is extremely difficult not to be utterly cynical about every damn thing written or presented about the UFO phenomenon. Rather than getting overwhelmed and exhausted ploughing through the endless claims and counter-claims, or taking the easy way out by “taking sides” in this confusingly multi-sided debate – I suggest you keep an open mind, use your natural B.S. detector and stay watchful as the many stories unfold. If you’ve read my article “Ley Lines, Wild Sabbats & Little Green Men” (see http://www.ancientmysteriesnet.org/wild_sabbats.html) then you will have some of my developing perspective on the matter: that whatever is behind the phenomenon, it has been going on throughout human history; nobody knows the whole story; and it appears to be very “metaphysical” or “quantum-physical” in nature, which is why there are so many different terms of reference being used, creating a real Tower of Babel situation, just to add to the confusion of all the different agendas we have to take account of.

It is perfectly okay to be reticent about doing practical spellcraft. This is better than going in boots and all in a superficial fashion. I would say that you probably have submerged past life memories of how powerful these things can be, and therefore do not feel in any great hurry to “experiment”. It is good to only do in magick what you **must** do, but don’t be so tentative that you neglect to work for those things that your soul desires – this too is a “must do”. One way of maximising power for your spellcraft is to frame the intention of your working to include the good of many more people than just you and yours.

Also include a “factor X” component. This is whatever your ego-persona/bodymind can’t think of, that the Gods would know about, so they can input any adjustment needed. It is also an opening for more to be included in the result than we could ever possibly imagine. It is a “given” that you will do your best to “get it right”; that you will work with respect, therefore acknowledge your own intuition. Don’t let perfectionism cripple you into inaction. Just get on with it; do your best on the day; trust your Self, and trust that the Powers of Greater Nature will take care of whatever is “left out”. Natural Magick is hardly an “exact science” – it is more of an Art and a Craft.

The Craft part of it is mostly learning, via the substance, material or tool you are working with, how to **concentrate**, how to concentrate Spirit into Matter, how to create consciously (Dream lucidly). So just go for it, and work for what you want by placing yourself in the wider picture and scheme of things. Just think - without the fulfilment of your Nature (your individual needs, wants and deep desires) Greater Nature is incomplete. You are important; you are part of the Continuum of Greater Nature: your Gate of immediate Circumstances, your Bodymind, your House/Community (your Soul-Clan, your true “family”, your deep magickal lineage) and the Land/Greater Nature where you are... all of these realities that you are a part of are the one Continuum, all equally powerful in the unfolding of Greater Nature.

Anyway, it is really great that you are getting less nervous about witchcraft and magick. You are very sensitive, so you probably feel the power of things in your whole system. ****If you send me your birth details: date, time (a.m. or p.m.) and location, there will be indications in your astrological natal chart regarding what specific style of psychism you were born with.** Most people are born with the potential to develop any psychic skill whatsoever. A certain percentage of people are born with a specialised psychic skill already in place. The latter group actually have a hard time with certain aspects of active psychic and metaphysical development because they have had to suppress their faculties and sensibilities from earliest childhood because they are disturbing to those around them who don't have those expanded sense perceptions.

**** I am not a qualified astrologer, but have acquired a good working knowledge of astrology as a branch of learning and practice fundamental to any Western Magickal Tradition of Natural Magick. I use astrology frequently as a valuable modality in reading and healing consultations.**

***After ritual work I usually get headaches at the base of the skull. I'm wondering whether the breathing technique I was taught to use has something to do with it. I didn't get a headache after the Circle Workshop we did at the Central Coast.

What kind of ritual work are you are doing when you get these headaches? I suspect that the breathing technique may well have something to do with it, especially if you are over-tense when you do the technique. Over-use of the left-brain, lack of grounding; using the delicate energy channels in the head instead of sending power through the whole body in a grounded way – it could be a number of things. Sometimes it is just that you are trying to work with energies that are not right for you and there is a “jamming signal” from your inner guides because you are not listening to them and you leave them no other option for them to get your attention. Sometimes it just indicates “overload” – expressing physically as pressure on the brain's fine blood-vessels. Hope these suggested causes shed some light on the matter, but I will have to fine-tune with you on that one. My feeling is that you didn't get a headache from the Gate Rite, because if nothing else, I really work on grounding more than anything, because that is the foundation, and it is after all the **Earthgate** Tradition...

I feel the clue to your occipital headaches is very much to do with the frontal energy centre of the Third Eye, and its corresponding posterior energy centre which is linked to the pituitary gland, (see Coven Culture column of Issue 40). Abuse of alcohol or other substances that give the brain a “quick fix” of blood-sugar, (the blood-brain barrier thing) often results from the blood-sugar rollercoastering commonly experienced by many psychically sensitive people. The alcohol of course does

temporarily give the brain the blood-sugar it needs, but it only creates a worsening spiral of blood-sugar imbalance and alcohol addiction, not to mention the individual being plunged unconsciously into the lower-astral.

Escaping into the astral is another crude attempt to blunt sensitivity, which (like suicide) is no escape at all, and only amplifies and distorts the original feelings... Even if you do not use alcohol, there can be a similar energy imbalance in relation to certain foods that keeps you ungrounded. This is an unconscious thing that we do when we don't feel safe in the world: we eat foods that stop us being fully grounded in to our bodies. Ritual is about bringing power into the physical plane, and if there are blockages in our energy bodies that prevent this from happening, the resistance to those energies trying to "come through" may be felt as discomfort or pain. As I mentioned, it could also be the result of conflicting energies, an incompatibility with the energies trying to come through, for whatever reason.

I would check with a naturopath, but the amino acid L – Glutamine is considered by some to be a good support for evening out blood-sugar imbalances. Also make sure that you do not have a digestive enzyme deficiency, liver dysfunction or other related disorders. Metaphysically, the headaches are likely to be a combination of exhaustion and blockage, an accumulation of toxic astral density. In the right hands, Cranio-Sacral Balancing can be a powerful healing modality for clearing this on very subtle frequencies. It is also quite possible that your sensitivity was registering the undisciplined lifestyle-habits of your fellow ritualists in regard to unconscious lower astral energies. Psychic sensitives, more than most, need to be particularly careful who they work ritual with!

During that 12 months I am (within reason) on tap for questions and support regarding the student/member's magickal path, and I do a lot of fine-tuning and send additional supplementary material, designing remedial material in response to individual needs. This means that Students/Members get a very good deal for their \$150 per year. **(If you want to be a Member and not do the training, that is fine, however if you want to become a Student, Membership is required).**
